37years, Female, Negative family history

With a history of locally advanced right breast cancer in 2009 which was treated by breast conservation surgery and axillary lymph node dissection (four out of fourteen lymph nodes involved and surgical margins were positive) followed by chemotherapy and radiotherapy.

Local recurrence happened one year later, therefore she underwent mastectomy and chemotherapy. In 2017 she experienced chest wall recurrence treated by local excision.

Loco-regional recurrence occurred in 2018 next to clavicle compatible with chondrosarcoma in pathology.

**Recommended plan:** Chemotherapy Regimens to be re-evaluated, if they were intensive we should consider re-radiotherapy and surgery, if not it is better to try more intensive systemic therapy.
