47 years, Female, Negative family history

- Bilateral breast masses, Core needle biopsy performed : infiltrating lobular carcinoma ER+ PR+ HER- E-Cadherin - Ki67:5%.

- Concomitant Dyspepsia, upper endoscopy was done: thickened folds were seen in body and fundus, so biopsy was taken : undifferentiated carcinoma. ER+ PR+ CDH1- GATTA3 + GCFP15 + CDX2- CK7 + CK20 +, consistent with metastatic lobular carcinoma from breast origin.

- Brain CT: Normal, Abdominal CT: suspected soft tissue infiltration around celiac axis and mesenteric root.

- WBS: Diffuse bone marrow involvement/ metastasis or metabolic bone disease.
