Patient presentation:

37 years/ Family history -

History of ulcerative lesions on her right breast since 2013.

Excisional biopsy performed in 2017; result: well differentiated Squamous Cell Carcinoma with involved lateral margin.

Owing to presence of a non-healing ulcer: biopsy repeated. Result: not concordant with previous pathology, presence of sub-acute dermatitis. Another biopsy performed, result: compatible with normal skin tissue

Question: plan?

Recommended tests: multiple skin biopsy from different parts of the ulcer

Recommended plan: surgery is strongly recommended- type of surgery depends on the result of new skin biopsies
