Patient presentation:

- 43 yrs -FH
- Presented with left breast masses.
- Ultrasound: 17 mm mass with a 20 mm lymphadenopathy in left axilla.
- Underwent core needle biopsy
- Pathology: invasive ductal carcinoma, ER+ PR+ HER2 equivocal, Ki67: 10%.
- She had a mass in her left kidney that had clear cell carcinoma characteristics in core biopsy.
- There were some 8 mm nodules in her right lung compatible with benign findings.

Question: surgical planning and chemotherapy timing?

Recommended tests:-- FISH test must be done

Recommended plan: sequence of surgery and chemotherapy depends on HER2 status
