Patient presentation:

- 58 years, negative family history

- Presented with right breast invasive ductal carcinoma
- Pathology: invasive ductal carcinoma, T=2.5 cm, one out of 7 lymph nodes involved, ER+ PR + HER2 +
- She had another mass in her left breast which was compatible with fibroadenoma based on imaging and frozen section but eventually permanent pathology described it as a benign phyllodes tumor. This mass had been excised without normal margin during surgery.

Question: Does she need margin re-excision of the benign phyllodes tumor?

Recommended tests: No further test needed

Recommended plan: Adjuvant radiotherapy for right breast followed by either reexcision or follow up of contralateral phyllodes tumor ³S/Disease
