Patient presentation:

- 45 years – negative family history

- History of oral contraceptive consumption for 15 years

- She experienced bilateral mastalgia recently

- Mammography : BIRADS 0

- Ultrasound : right breast had a 7*4 mm hypoechoic mass at 11 o'clock B4a. left breast had a 22* 10 mm tissue distortion at 4 o'clock B4c

- MRI : right breast was normal . 25*20 mm mass at 4 o'clock of left breast B5.

Core needle biopsy: right invasive lobular carcinoma. left: invasive lobular carcinoma. Fine needle aspiration of axillary lymph nodes was negative.

Question: Plan of surgery ? does she need genetic consult?

Recommended tests: Genetic consult . repeat MRI if breast conservation is considered

Recommended plan: bilateral mastectomy and sentinel lymph node biopsy is recommended although breast conservation is not discouraged
