Patient presentation:

- 40 years – negative family history
- Presented with suspicious axillary lymphadenopathy. Ultrasound guided biopsy was done
- Pathology: metastatic carcinoma , ER + PR +
- MRI: focal non-mass enhancement in centro-lateral zone (BIRADS 4).
Mammography : BIRADS 4c. ultrasound guided biopsy was performed.
- Pathology: usual ductal hyperplasia
- metastasis work up ,upper and lower GI endoscopy were normal.

Question: shall we consider it as breast cancer ? does she need more assessment ?

Recommended tests: Targeted re-biopsy

Considered plan: wire excision of BIRADS 4c lesion with adequate margins + lymph node dissection
