Patient presentation:

- 47years – positive family history (her aunt)
- Presented with irregular hypo-echoic mass in her left breast based on ultrasound (BIRADS 4). Mammography BRADS 4.underwent core needle biopsy
- Pathology: invasive ductal carcinoma, ER + (95 %), PR +(70%) HER – Ki67 7%
- Breast conservation and sentinel lymph node biopsy was done.
- Pathology: invasive ductal carcinoma, 1.5 cm, grade 1/3, negative margins, negative
- She has multiple comorbid conditions such as brain shunt, hypertension, fatty liver grade 3 , and is morbidly obese

Question: is she eligible for chemotherapy?

Recommended tests: Oncotype DX

Considered plan: chemotherapy can be suggested to her as well as hormone therapy
