Patient Presentation:

-A 58 year old female with left breast mass diagnosed with breast cancer (IDC, G2, no LVI, Luminal A: ki67 10-15%). She had tumoral involvement of axillary LN in FNA and underwent metastatic work up.

-Her bone scan showed multiple bone metastases.

Question: Which one is more justified now, surgery or systemic therapy?

Recommended Plan: Spine MRI to evaluate spines should be done; then systemic therapy is recommended first.
