Patient Presentation:

- A 58 year old female presented with locally advanced (T4) left breast cancer (FNA of mass: positive for malignancy) which had penetrated deeply to axillary region.

-The patient received NAC for one year without any clinical response.

-In thoracic CT scan axillary vessels are reported to be involved. She has no neurologic symptoms of left upper limb.

Question: Is surgery recommended?

Recommended Plan: IHC and MRI of brachial plexus should be done; if brachial plexus was not involved, surgery is recommended.
