Patient Presentation:

- A 48 year old female with past history of breast cancer 8 years ago presented with bone pain.
- She had history of a pulmonary lesion at her first diagnosis which had been biopsied and diagnosed as hamartoma.
- Bone scan was done which showed increased uptake in lower cervical spines and T7.
- PET scan showed increased uptake in C6 and C7 spines.

Question: Plan?

Recommended Plan: Biopsy and IHC of bone lesion should be done to confirm the metastases; after that, consultation with a neurosurgeon, RT, and administration of aromatase inhibitors is recommended.
