Patient's Name: Z.R.

Responsible Physician: Dr. Maddah.

Patient Presentation:

-A 41 year old female with breast cancer underwent NAC followed by MRM.

-Pathology: IDC, T=1cm, LVI+, G2, 2 out of 13 LNs involved, ER+, HER2+, Ki67 70%;

-She presented with supraclavicular and cervical LAP while she was receiving adjuvant RT; FNA of the LNs confirmed tumoral involvement.

Question: Is surgery recommended?

Recommended Plan: PET scan and MRI of the brachial plexus should be done; if there was no other lesion and brachia plexus was not involved, surgery can be offered.
