**Patient Presentation:**

- A 54 year old female diagnosed with left breast cancer (IDC, ER+, PR+, HER2 2+, Ki67 20%).
- Breast MRI showed a suspicious lesion in right breast (B4). Lesion could not be detected in US, so CNB was not done.

**Question:** What should be done for management of right breast lesion?

**Recommended Plan:** Target US (for right breast lesion detection) and FISH should be done. NAC can be recommended for left breast cancer.
