Patient Presentation:

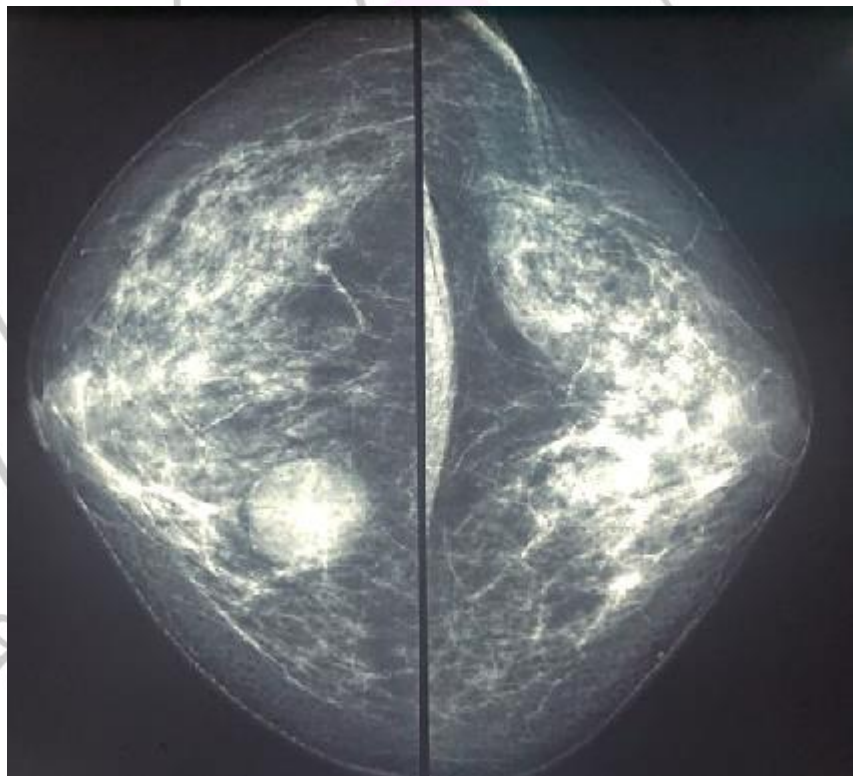
-A 50 year old female with cervical LAP diagnosed as large B–cell lymphoma and received chemotherapy.
