Patient Presentation:

-A 53 year old female with past history of left breast mass excision 8 years ago(pathology: Adenosis) presented with left axillary lymphadenopathy. CNB of the LN revealed metastatic ductal carcinoma(ER-, PR-, HER+, Ki35-40%, GATA+). Breast US, MRI and mammogram was normal. Thoracic and abdominopelvic CT scan and bone scan was normal too.

Question: Plan?

Recommended Plan: NAC followed by surgery (preferably MRM) and then adjuvant RT is recommended.
