Patient Presentation:

-A 50 year old female with positive family history of breast cancer (sister 40 year old) presented with right breast cancer and underwent MST + SLNB.

-Pathology: IDC, T=35mm (DCIS 50%), G2, free margins, LVI -, ER +, PR+, HER2 -, Ki67 10%, no LN involvement (0/1).

-She refused adjuvant systemic treatment for 3 months.

-Recent metastatic work up: A suspicious lesion in distal of right femur.

-Femur X ray: Intraosseous lesion.

Question: What should be done for evaluation of bone lesion? Regarding 3 months delay, is adjuvant systemic therapy is still beneficial?

Recommended Plan: Bone MRI and lesion biopsy should be done. Adjuvant systemic therapy is recommended.
