Patient Presentation:

- A 41 year old female with past history of left breast cancer 3 years ago which had been underwent BCS+SLNB(Pathology: IDC, G3, T=2.5cm, free margins, ER-, HER2 +, 2 LNs without tumoral involvement) followed by ChemoRT, presented with left breast mass(adjacent to previous tumor site) diagnosed as breast cancer. She underwent MST.

-Pathology: IDC, G2, T=1.5cm, LVI+, ER-, PR-, HER2 +, Ki67 70-80%; no LN was found.

Question: What should be done about axilla?

Recommended Plan: Her surgeon should be consulted about details of surgery; no adjuvant RT is needed; systemic therapy is recommended.
