Patient Presentation:

- A45 year old female known case of left breast cancer
- Surgery: breast conserving surgery and SLNB, 6 months ago
- Pathology: T1N0 (T1.7cm), lympho-vascular invasion-, grade I
- Immunohistochemistry: ER+, PR+, HER-, Ki67 10%,
- Adjuvant treatment: chemotherapy, radiotherapy after, radiation was finished 3 months ago, she has erythema and edema on her breast which has not improved. Biopsy was done and was negative for malignancy, she was referred by the oncologist for mastectomy

Question: Dose the patient need mastectomy?

Recommended Plan: Medical follow up with Pentoxifylline and vitamin E, no need for surgery
