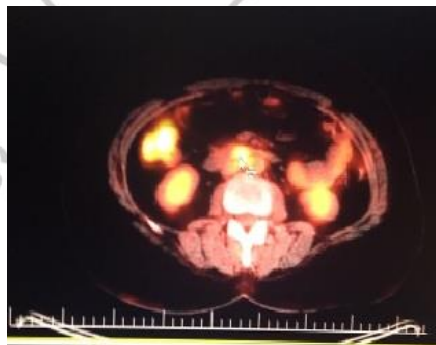

Patient Presentation:

- A 54 year old female who had breast cancer 5 years ago
- Surgery: BCS+ AD (T2.5 cm, N 16/21 +)
- Immunohistochemistry: ER +, PR+, HER2 –
- Adjuvant treatment: chemotherapy and radiation and tamoxifen after
- She experienced abdominal symptoms and investigations showed stage III ovarian cancer
- Neo-adjuvant treatment: 3 courses chemotherapy
- Surgery: underwent cyto-reductive surgery
- Pathology: cervix margin was involved and lymph nodes was positive.
- Adjuvant treatment: 3 courses chemotherapy radiation therapy and brachy-therapy and aromatase inhibitor
- Genetic test: BRCA checked and was negative.
- follow up: 2 years after CA125 raised and in PET scan uptakes were in breast and retro peritoneum
- Pathology: invasive ductal carcinoma in both sites.

Question: what are the next steps?

Recommended Plan: Surgery of in breast recurrence and lymph node and retroperitoneal disease, and chemotherapy after.
