- A 48 year old female known case of newly diagnosed bilateral breast cancer
- Sonography: right breast; mass 3cm in upper outer quadrant an suspicious axillary lymphadenopathy,
Left breast; 5*8mm lesion in central zone, reactive lymphadenopathy
- MRI: suspicious bilateral multifocal lesions
- Pathology: invasive ductal carcinoma
- Immunohistochemistry: ER+, PR+, HER2 -, Ki67 40% in right side and 10% in left side

Question: What is the next plan?

Recommended Plan: Bilateral mastectomy + sentinel lymph node biopsy
