Patient Presentation:

- A 29 year old female with positive family history in her mother (48 years old), she had left breast mastitis that did not improve, inflammatory breast cancer proved
 - Pathology: invasive ductal carcinoma, axillary node positive for malignancy
 - Immunohistochemistry: ER +, PR+, HER2 2+, FISH-, Ki67 35-40%
 - MRI: a lesion in right breast
 - Pathology: benign lesion
 - Neo-adjuvant treatment: chemotherapy
- She had good clinical response
- Genetic test: positive for BRCA2

Question: what are the next steps? Does early reconstruction possible?

Recommended Plan: MRM of left breast and late reconstruction, prophylactic mastectomy of right side and reconstruction of right side at the same time or after radiotherapy
