Patient Presentation:

- A70year old female, with bilateral breast masses
- Sonography: left breast heteroechoic mass 12*8.5 mm, right breast heteroechoic mass 41*24mm, BIRADS 4a
- Mammography: left breast; round mass in UIQ, right breast; lobulated mass in UIQ
- Core needle biopsy: papillary neoplasm with atypical cells suspicious for papillary neoplasm
- Surgery: bilateral lumpectomy
- Pathology: left breast: encapsulated papillary carcinoma, 1.2cm, tumor tangential to peripheral margins
right breast: encapsulated papillary carcinoma, 2.8cm, margins free from tumor
- Immunohistochemistry: ER+, PR+, HER2-, Ki67 5%

Question: what is the next plan?

Recommended Plan: Bilateral radiotherapy, hormone therapy, genetic consult
