Patient Presentation:

- A 34year old female with left breast cancer 1 year ago
- Neo-adjuvant treatment: chemotherapy
- Surgery: BCS+ Axillary lymph node dissection
- Pathology: Invasive ductal carcinoma, free margins, 12 uninvolved lymph nodes
- Immunohistochemistry: ER+, PR+, HER2-, Ki67 25%
- Adjuvant treatment: radiotherapy, tamoxifen
- Bone scan: suspicious lesion in sternal body and L3
- MRI: suspicious lesion in L3
- Biopsy of L3 lesion: negative for neoplasm
- Image review in tumor board: there is metastases in sternum and L3

Question: what is the next plan?

Recommended Plan: changing of tamoxifen to Aromatase inhibitor, re-evaluating patient after 6 months
