Patient Presentation:

- A 61year old female, right breast cancer, HBS Ag positive
- Surgery: MRM
- pathology: stage IA
- Immunohistochemistry: ER-, PR-, Her2+
- Adjuvant treatment: chemotherapy 5 courses due to flare of hepatitis + Herceptin
- 1 year after: liver mass in follow up sonography
- Biopsy: metastatic carcinoma
- Immunohistochemistry: ER+ 10%, PR+30%, Her2+
- PET scan: liver mass 18*17mm in segment III
- Systemic treatment: 3 courses chemotherapy with Taxol and Herceptin
- Abdominal CT scan: liver mass 7mm
- HBS Ag PCR: viral load: undetectable

Question: what is the next plan?

Recommended Plan: brain MRI, liver metastasectomy
