Patient Presentation:

-A 57 year old female presented with left locally advanced breast cancer with diffuse involvement of left anterior hemithorax and axilla and axillary vein, which was not operable.

- She underwent RT+chemotherapy.

- After 5 sessions of chemotherapy there was no remarkable clinical response and post chemotherapy thoracic CT scan showed invasion of axillary vein by tumor.

Question: Is surgery justified?

Recommended Plan: Further chemotherapy, no surgical intervention now.
