Patient Presentation:

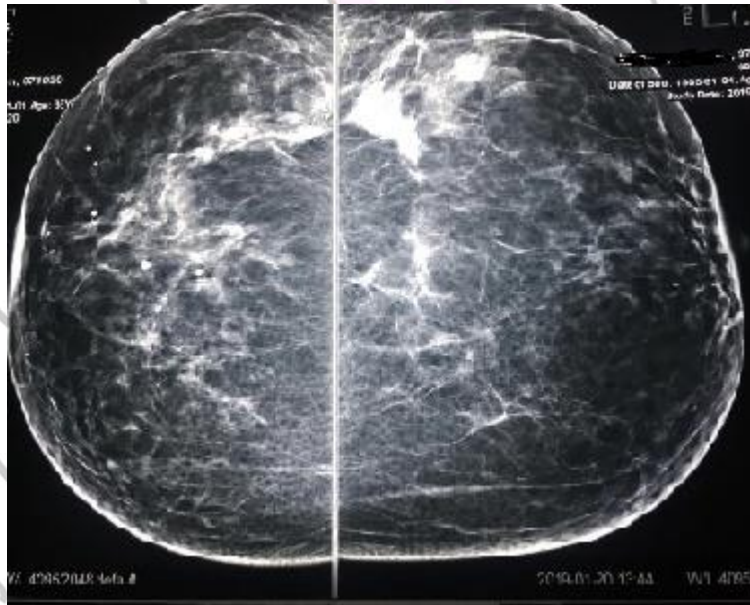
-A 36 year old female with nipple ulcer, diagnosed as paget disease, had been underwent BCS+SLNB.

-Pathology examination reported high grade DCIS with microinvasion, which was negative for ER and PR and positive for HER-2.

-Pathology review reported no invasion.

Question: Is third pathologic review is needed to decide about adjuvant treatment?

Recommended Plan: Chemotherapy should be administered according to the decision of responsible physician; it is not obvious that third opinion will be helpful.
