Patient Presentation:

-A 42 year old female with past history of bilateral breast cancer, which had underwent BCS.

-She had strong family history of breast cancer and underwent BRCA testing, which was positive for BRCA2.

-Bilateral mastectomy has been proposed to patient, but she is reluctant to accept it.

Question: Is bilateral mastectomy and salpingo-oophorectomy warranted?

Recommended Plan: Bilateral mastectomy and salpingo-oophorectomy should be proposed, with more emphasis on bilateral salpingo-oophorectomy, as it is more necessary than mastectomy in her condition.

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
