**Patient Presentation:**

-A 64 year old female with history of right breast cancer 2 years ago which had underwent MRM (ER-, PR-, HER-2 +).

-She had positive family history of breast cancer (mother:50 year old, daughter:35 year old).

-In her follow up mammography of left breast, benign type microcalcification (which reported to be ductal hyperplasia in biopsy) was reported. She has done breast MRI.

**Question:** Imaging review? is biopsy recommended?

**Recommended Plan:** In MRI review, no suspicious lesions is seen. As a year has passed since the last mammography, new annual mammography should be done.
