**Patient Presentation:**

-A 57 year old female presented with left ulcerative locally advanced breast cancer with diffuse involvement of left hemithorax and axilla extending to right breast(IDC, G2, ER+, Her2-, ki67 20%) two years ago; in staging she had lung metastasis.

-She underwent chemotherapy with no remarkable local response. In her new thoracic CT scan no metastasis was detected.

**Question:** Hormone therapy? Plan?

**Recommended Plan:** Hormone therapy can be administered. Palliative surgery is not recommended due disease extent.
