Patient's Name: R.A.

Patient Presentation:

-A 35 year old pregnant female(36 weeks of pregnancy) diagnosed with breast cancer and liver masses. She underwent BCS+SLNB.

-Pathology examination reported T=6cm, involved margins, one involved LN(1/7), ER+, HER 2-, Ki67 15%.

-After delivery, she received chemotherapy plus GNRH agonist, followed by re-surgery (T=3.5cm, free margins).

-After surgery, she received internal and external radiation therapy followed by Tamoxifen plus Diphhereline.

-Now, her follow up breast MRI shows masses in her left breast, and her CEA level has increased.

Question: What should be done for reported breast lesions?

Recommended Plan: MRI lesions are suspicious; target US and biopsy is recommended.
