Patient Presentation:

-A 60 year old female with breast cancer underwent MRM. Pathology examination reported IDC and mucinous carcinoma, T=4.5cm, G2, ER+, HER2 +, Ki 67 6%. No LN was found in the specimen. In the pathology review, no LN was found either.

-Her post-operative US shows one axillary LN with increased cortical thickness.

Question: As axilla stage is not known, what should be done?

Recommended Plan: Pathology review of the main specimen should be done; if still no LN is found, as RT is indicated in this patient regarding tumor's characteristics, chemoRT can be initiated without axillary staging.
