- Presented with palpable Right breast masses.

-Ultrasound: BIRADS 4. Two masses.8o'clock mass spiculated 22mm. 10 o'clock well defined mass 9 mm.

Mammography: BIRADS 4(round spiculated mass at deep portion)

- Core needle biopsy: IDC; ER+; PR+; HER2-; Ki67 35%

- Metastatic work up revealed: Some nodules up to 15 mm in right thyroid lobe, some calcified subpleural nodules up to4mm in Left lower lobe, some hypodense lesions up to20 mm in liver between segment 3 and 4, Hyperenhancing42 mm mass with internal necrosis suggesting left Renal cell carcinoma

**Question**: How is the plan of treatment?

Recommended tests: 1-Dynamic MRI of abdomen & pelvis.2- Thyroid sonography.
