Patient presentation:

- 55years female
 - Left breast Upper Outer Quadrant mass and positive axillary Lymph Nodes in Sonography
 - Past medical history of CRF (Chronic Renal Failure) and rejection of kidney Transplant and now has arteriovenous fistula in her left hand.
- Also, there is history of CVA (cerebrovascular accident) and warfarin usage.
- Her (ejection fraction) is EF >30%.
 - Hemodialysis is done every other day.
 - Because of the aforementioned problems breast mass biopsy is not done.

Question: What should be done?

Recommended tests: Consider internal medicine consult. There is no contraindication to Core needle biopsy and it can be done for the next planning.
