**Patient presentation:**

- 39 years female

- Presented with right breast cancer (1395) Breast conserving surgery plus Intraoperative Radiotherapy (IORT) had been done.

-Pathology (1395): IDC; medial margin closed and focal involvement seen (ER+; PR+; HER2 1+; Ki67 50%; 36 out of 51 lymph nodes harvested were involved).

After her chemotherapy only received tamoxifen till 1396.

-1398 suspicious skin lesion in bed of mastectomy proved to be involved so modified radical mastectomy done. (IDC; ER-; PR-; HER23+; Ki67 20%) then chemotherapy began. One month later some skin lesions appeared and increased by time.

-Now (1399) breast MRI showed increased enhancement of right mastectomy site in upper inner quadrant and Metastatic left axillary lymph node. Albeit she is continuing her chemotherapy both lesions are growing?

**Question:** What to do? Can palliative surgical resection be useful?

**Considered plan:** Surgery is not recommended, consider changing the line of treatment.



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
