Patient presentation: A 36 year-old lady with a left breast mass (8/99)
Clinical diagnosis (pathologically proven): inflammatory breast carcinoma
Mets workup: multiple bone & lung metastases;
followed by 8 sessions of chemotherapy and Herceptin
One month ago she experienced severe headaches which was due to a brain mass
which received 10 sessions of brain Radiation
Pathology: ILC,G1, ER+, HER2 +, Ki67 40%

Question:

- 1.Is primary surgery considered (now or future)?
2. Does brain lesion need additional treatment?

Recommendation:

- 1.Brain CT has multiple brain metastases.
- 2.Palliative treatment (xeloda+Lapatinib).
