**Patient presentation:** A 67 year-old woman, known case of breast cancer since 19 years ago.

81: DCIS in CNBx, lumpectomy and ALND? And RT+HT (Tamoxifen, 5years)

90: Mastectomy and RT and 5years Tamoxifen

99.10: Orbital metastasis presented, RT and CHT

WBS (99.11): Supralat of left orbit,

CT: a lobulated 60mm left adrenal mass

Orbital mass Bx: Metastatic Ductal Carcinoma, ER+ (90%), PR-, Her2 +, Ki67 15%

Adrenal Bx: insufficient, re Bx is recommended

CT: 35mm left adrenal mass (malignant); dilated Hepatic bile duct (EUS is recommended)

**Question:**

What is the next plan?

**Recommendation:**

1. Chemotherapy and then PET scan.
2. EUS is recommended.
