Patient presentation:

- 78 years , family history colon cancer
- Presented as known case of obstructive colon & bilateral breast cancer
- Pathology : Rt hemicolecotomy, poorly diff carcinoma, margin free, muscle invasion, 25 LN free, Liver bx negative 8/2019
- -Bilateral Mastectomy , Rt ALND - Lt SLNB ,9/2019
- IDC , Rt 2cm, LT 3 Cm, both G1, margin free , LVI negative , Rt ALND 4/12 ,, Lt SLN 0/8
- CHEMO 6 course CMF ended 1/2020-
- RTx of Rt breast *25 ended in 5/2020
- Letrozol & Xeloda until now
- New problem: bilateral visual deficits (progressive)
- Brain MRI 8/2020: enhancement in optic nerve-chiasma-tract & Frontal horns (metastatic)+ Old meningioma

Question: Are these Meningeal carcinomatosis?

Recommended tests: PET; without any additional benefit

Recommended plan: Cervicothoracolumbar spine MRI then if positive for metastasis do Intrathecal chemo therapy + whole Brain Rx
