Patient presentation:

- 50 years

- Last year Locally advanced breast cancer, Triple negative,
- NAC(ACT+Taxol+palbocyclib) performed, then MRM and radiation therapy
- Now: local recurrence at axillary tail on the lateral part of previous scar. A large ulcerative & very hard mass preventing arm abduction and elevation.
- Whole body bone scan: Neg Thorax CT scan: Neg

Question: Shall we do surgery? or first chemotherapy then operation? Curative or palliative chemotherapy? Curative or palliative surgery?

Recommended work up: due to following findings:

In CT scan deep margin of the mass seems to be adherent to 2nd Rib –there is pleural nodule- contralateral axilla is suspicious

Recommended Plan: perform sonography of both breasts and axillas & PET scan and then chemotherapy
