- Sentinel lymph node biopsy: all 6 Lymph nodes were free(0/6)

Question: Does she need chemotherapy? Which hormone therapy is better (Tamoxifen or letrozole?)

Recommended tests: no further test needed

Considered plan: Due to pathologic nature of the tumor (pure mucinous type) chemotherapy can be ignored; for hormone therapy now use of tamoxifen and after menopause letrozole recommended.
