Patient presentation:

- 55 years, Female
- History of previous breast cancer underwent Breast conserving surgery (2015) unfortunately main documents lost ER + ; PR+(5% mild intensity), HER2 - , Ki 67: 28-30%
- Received 8 courses chemotherapy (probably AC → T)+ and radiotherapy) + Tamoxifen
- In Routine follow up She experienced Recent contralateral breast mass that eventuated to Breast conserving surgery (As yet under tamoxifen treatment) Invasive Ductal Carcinoma 2.3 cm, SLN 0/2 + DCIS 20% grade 3, necrosis + , Lymphovascular invasion - , Perineural invasion-, ER-; PR; HER2 -, Ki67: 50-55%
- Now she is referred for radiotherapy

Question: Does she need chemotherapy before radiotherapy?

Recommended plan: First do chemotherapy.
