Responsible Physician: Dr. Elahi

Patient Presentation: A 57 year old female with right axillary mass (98/10)

Physical exam: T2N2

Core needle biopsy: IDC

Immunohistochemistry: ER-, PR -, HER2+++, Ki67 60%

Imaging: axillary tail mass

Metastases work-up (98/10): right supraclavicular and posterior cervical lymphadenopathy

Treatment: chemotherapy 8 courses and herceptin

Re-evaluation (99/3): No mass in breast and axilla and neck

Metastases work-up: normal (complete response)

Question: What is the next plan?

Recommended Plan: surgery of breast and axilla+ radiation to supraclavicular and cervical region+ herceptin
