Patient's Name: S. M

Responsible Physician: Dr. Sadighi

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A 39 year old female with locally advanced right breast cancer 5 years ago

Surgery: BCS

Adjuvant treatment: chemotherapy+ radiotherapy+ herceptin+ diphereline+ letraozol

Pathology: intralymphatic invasive ductal carcinoma, grade III, free axillary lymph node; Immunohistochemistry: triple positive, Ki67 40%

2 years later there were nodules in right breast

Biopsy: invasive ductal carcinoma, grade III

Immunohistochemistry: Ki67 60%, triple positive ; Surgery: Mastectomy

Pathology: 4cm, involved one out of nine lymphnodes

Adjuvant treatment: TC +Herceptin

2 years later left breast inflammatory with multiple nearby skin satellite nodules .

Pathology: invasive ductal carcinoma

Immunohistochemistry: hormone receptor negative, HER2 positive

Metastases work up: negative for metastases

she took different single agent chemotherapy plus Herceptin from that time; now her disease is limited to left breast, she is symptomatic with heavy involved left breast, there is no response to hormone therapy

Question: Is surgery possible?

Recommended Plan: Left breast surgery+ right supraclavicular lesion followed by systemic therapy
