A 49 year old female with history of bilateral breast cancer seeking for prophylactic advices

left breast: 12 years ago, Triple negative breast cancer, underwent BCS (omega type of incision)+ SLNB (free)+ chemotherapy+ Radiotherapy

Right breast: 2 years ago, underwent BCS (omega type of incision)+ SLNB+ chemotherapy+ radiotherapy

Pathology: invasive carcinoma with medullary features, 2.6 cm, grade III, free margins, ER+, PR-, HER2-, Ki67 70%, two free lymph nodes she is been on femora for 18 months.

Mammography (11/98): a regional microcalcification, B3 which appeared B2 on control MLO 6 months later

breast MRI (3/99): B2

Genetic test: BRCA1 mutation (Exons 12-14 deletion)

Question: Is bilateral mastectomy recommended? Is she candidate for nipple sparing mastectomy? Is bilateral salpingoophorectomy recommended?

Recommended Plan: mastectomy or follow up both are considerable, bilateral salpingoophorectomy is recommended
