**Patient presentation:** A 60 year-old woman with right breast cancer and mastectomy+ tamoxifen about 23 years ago(MRM, 2 positive LN) and then orbital metastatic mass (86) and left Breast Cancer, Left supraclavicular and Axillary LAP and Bone metastasis, underwent left BCS+CHRT(88) and orbital mass excision and letrozole, and therefore, she presented scalp mass recently(99) underwent excisional Bx and Femara.

Left Breast Cancer IHC: ER+,PR-,HER2+(3+), Ki67 -

Surgical Pathology (scalp lesion): metastatic carcinoma, ER+, PR-, HER2 -, Ki67 5-7%

PET scan: Multiple bone lesions without any activity
