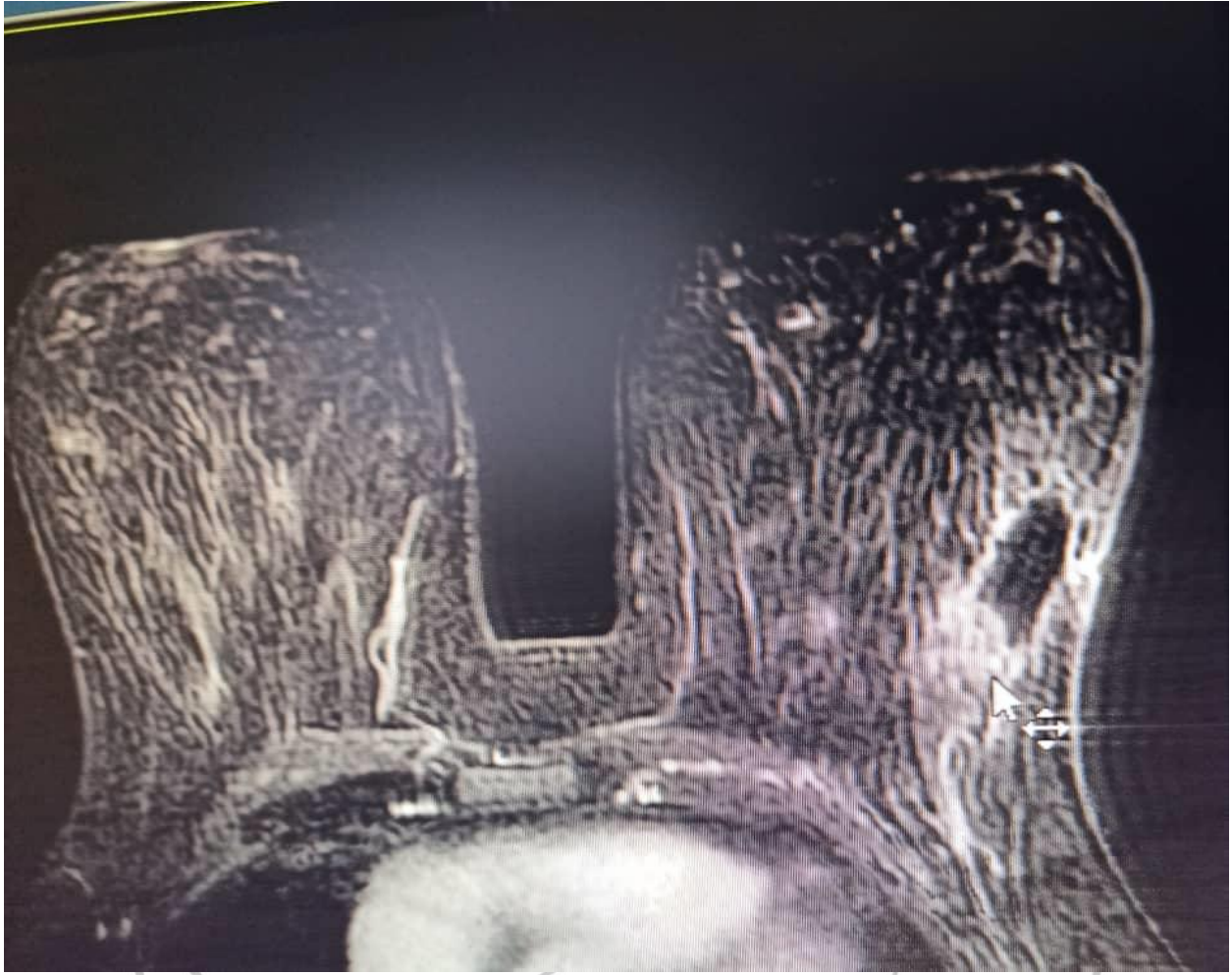
**Patient presentation:**

- 40years – female
- Presented with left breast mass. Ultrasound: BIRADS 4b confirmed by mammography.
- CNB of mass: IDC; Grade2; LVI (lymphovascular invasion present)
- BCS (breast conserving surgery) done: IDC (5\*4cm); lateral and superior margin involved by DCIS. One out of 5 sentinel lymph nodes involved by tumor.
- PET scan: only positive finding one 14 mm active lymph node of level one left axilla.
- Breast MRI: BIRADS 4, perioperative site nodular suspicious enhancement.

**Question:** Is there any need for reoperation?

**Recommended tests:** Targeted ultrasound and Radiologic consultation if breast conserving is considered.

**Considered plan:** Surgery including complete ALND.

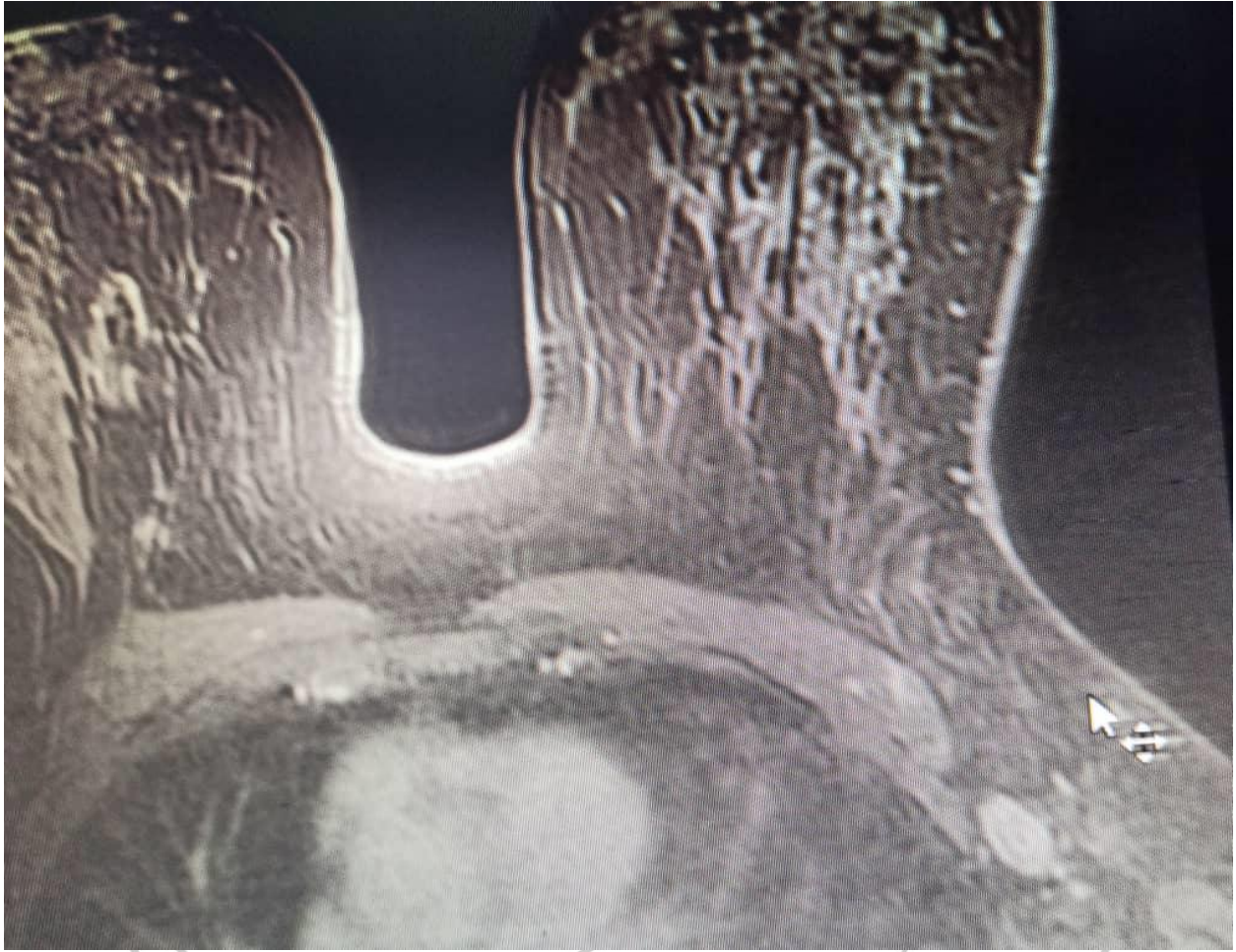


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
