A 52 year-old lady with a history of right breast cancer underwent BCS + SLNB (TNBC, G3, Ki67 25%, 2/4 LN) , followed by chemotherapy & radiotherapy (98.4) ,presented breast skin lesions recently.

Skin Biopsy: IDC, TNBC

PET: T7 lesion

Spinal MRI: T7 lesion (Biopsy confirmed metastatic lesion)

MG: Right UOQ mass (B3)

Question:

What's the next plan?

Surgery or chemotherapy or chemotherapy followed by surgery ?

Recommendation:

- 1.Systemic chemotherapy and spinal radiotherapy.
- 2.Surgery recommended if bone metastasis responded to systemic and local treatment.
3. Genetic consult.
