Surgical pathology: DCIS, low grade & intermediate grade, ER+(90%), PR+(90%), HER2-, Ki67 15%, lateral & deep margins=1mm

Question:

What is the next plan?

Recommendation:

- 1.MRI review: left axillary suspicious lymph node & right enhancing clump lesion that needs magnified view.
- 2.Magnified view & targeted US is needed.
- 3.Reexcision or mastectomy, both of them could be recommended.
