A 59 year-old woman with left breast mass who underwent VAB, then get tamoxifen about 2 months and bilateral reduction mammoplasty and excision of left side LCIS and microcalcification

FH: positive (her sister and her niece, both of them under 40)

MG: left LIQ microcalcification(B4)

U/S: Iso hypoecho mass 10*15mm mass in left 6 o'clock (B4c)

VABx: LCIS, G1, ER+

MRI: Right (B2)

Genetic test: negative

Surgical pathology: ILC, G2, LVI+, T=2cm, multifocal (2 foci), free margins

Question:

What is the next plan?

Recommendation:

1. Left side SLNBx.
2. Left NSM(nipple sparing mastectomy) is considering.
