Patient presentation:

A 73 year-old woman with right breast mass since 6 months ago with partial response to chemotherapy after 4 sessions and discontinues chemotherapy because of chemotherapy side effects.

Physical exam: Right 5cm breast mass & multiple LAP (T4N1)

CNB: IDC, ER+, PR+, HER2 -, Ki 67 70%

Lymph Node FNA: positive

Bone scan & MRI: bone metastasis(T10)(confirmed with Biopsy)

Question:

What is the next plan?

Should she undergo surgery or continue systemic therapy?

Recommendation:

1. Surgery (mastectomy) then hormone therapy.
2. Bone MRI.
