A 38 year-old lady with left inflammatory breast cancer (T4N1) since 7 months ago who underwent NACT(4/25)

FH:negative

Physical exam: Left UOQ 6cm mass+ multiple Ax LAP+ supraclavicular lymph node (before NAC), central huge mass with skin involvement (lower cervical to under IMF) +axillary LAP

CNBx:IDC,TN, ki67 80%

Metastasis W/U: negative

Chest CT: (5/10) Left breast 8mm mass and Axillary LAP and pectoralis major involvement and multiple sclerotic-lytic in thoracic spine & sternum+ 4.5 mm lung nodule+ Right adrenal mass

Bone scan: multiple bone metastases
